

So, we'll hope to see you all at "Something's Afoot" with toes tapping, sleuth minds working and laughter muscles engaged. Cheers,



Membership Update

Being a Players Theatre member entitles you to discounted tickets to shows as well as discounts on beverages and snacks at our bar. Membership also entitles you to attend special members only events as they occur.

We are transitioning our Membership system back to a single annual anniversary date system. That date will be the 31st of December each year.

Each year members will receive a reminder and instructions on how to renew their membership.

The transition period will be from now until Dec 31st 2020.

If your membership is due now you can renew it for the annual fee and be financial until Dec 31st 2020.

If your membership expires between the 1st June and 30 September 2020 you will be able to renew after the 1st June for half a year fee and be financial till Dec 31st 2020.

If your membership falls due between 1st October and 31st December, you will be able to renew after the 1st Oct for a quarter year fee and be financial till Dec 31st 2020.

From that point on you will receive a reminder to renew your membership as Dec 31st approaches to be financial until Dec 31st the following year.

After the transition period there will be two subscriptions. Full year subscription valid from January 1st till Dec 31st each year Half year subscription valid from July 1st till Dec 31st each year

If you renew your membership from home the transaction will be valid immediately and you will be able to log in and purchase a members discount ticket straight away.

Your membership card will be available at the theatre on your next visit.

To purchase tickets online, login using your email address, and please remember your password for future use. If you forget your password the system allows for you to have a Change Password email sent to you.

NOTE: The Theatre AGM is held in June each year and you need to be a financial member to nominate or participate in this very important event.

It is also important to note that in order to participate in any show in any capacity you need to be a valid financial member.
