
We have two shows to go this year with "A Doll's House" almost ready for opening night. Please see the following article for more information.

"A Doll's House"



Henrik Ibsen's classic drama written in 1879 and cleverly adapted by Director Hamish Keddie to prewar 1939 Norway. Assistant Director Emily Barham is Hamish Keddie's able assistant in this intriguing adaptation.

It is Christmas Eve, Oslo Norway, Germany marches across Europe and Norway is about to be invaded. The story revolves around Nora, superbly performed by Bianca Churcher. She is supported in her performance by husband Torvald played by talented Anthony Miles.

They have been married eight years and have three children cared for by their Nursemaid. Nora saved her husband's life by borrowing money from a man from Torvald's past, Nils Krogstad. Krogstad is conniving and ambitious and played by Paul Bishop.

Torvald is by appearances a good provider and a pillar of the community but in reality a weak man, sarcastic, controlling and treats his wife like a showpiece. Krogstad is ambitious and resorts to blackmail.


A story of a woman's fight for freedom in a world dominated by men. Is she right? Have times really changed? You be the judge.

This dramatic piece is supported by superb acting from a wonderful cast. Dr Rank, Torvald's friend and confident played by Jim Mitchell. Mrs Linde, Nora's friend from the past played by Janet Dawson. The Nursemaid of Nora's children and in fact Nora's nursemaid played by Margaret Nicolson and of course Lars, the family's butler played by Matthew Barnes.

So come along and join us on opening night, Friday 11th August, for this classic play.

"Me and My Girl"



The show revolves around an unapologetically, unrefined cockney gentleman named Bill who learns that he is the 14th heir to the Earl of Hareford. However, he will only receive his inheritance if Sir John and the Duchess approve of him. The Duchess feels that with a little grooming, Bill will be suitable to inherit the title – and the money. However, she insists that Bill break up with his cockney girlfriend, Sally.

Bill refuses to accept the title if he cannot keep Sally as his girl and so starts the comical conflict between the upper-class and the lower-class. Stephen Fry's revised book brings together this comical rags-to-riches in tight-breaches story supported by the nostalgic sound of Noel Gay's music.

This talented cast under the direction of Adrian Davis ably assisted by Jan

Cook will deliver a first-rate performance.

The rehearsals are now underway with this 29-strong cast and at the time of writing the band is meeting this week for their first rehearsal. 
The outstanding feature of this great festival was the friendship and camaraderie between the competing groups, all of whom wish to return in 2025.


